



## Audrey L. Winchell

July 20, 1929 - December 6, 2015

Audrey L. Winchell, age 86, of Mercer, passed away on Sunday, December 6, 2015 at her home. She was born on July 20, 1929 in Milwaukee, the daughter of Alfred and Hilda (nee Heuer) Hoewe. Audrey graduated from Nathan Hale High School in 1947 and Carroll College in 1951. In 1953, Audrey married Kenneth O. Winchell, Sr., with whom she shared 62 years of marriage. She worked for 32 years in the Waukesha School System as a Special Education Teacher and retired in 1991. Upon retirement, Audrey and Kenneth moved to Mercer. She was a longtime active member of the Manitowish Waters Community Church and Women's Guild. Audrey was a volunteer at the Koller Library, enjoyed gardening, was a true bird expert and belonged to the beloved "Way Up North" Bridge Club.
