



## Barbara E. Saving

June 18, 1922 - March 26, 2018

Barbara Everett Saving was born June 18, 1922 in Dearborn, Michigan to Guy and Ethel Everett. She had one brother, Robert, who died in 1943. Barb grew up in the Chicago area. She attended Lawrence University in Appleton Wisconsin prior to WWII. After the war she attended and graduated from the University of Wisconsin, Madison. She married John (Jack) Edwin Saving on April 8, 1944. He preceded her in death in 1989. They had two children: Peter (wife Linda) of Iron River, Michigan and Pamela of Wauwatosa, Wisconsin.
