On December 21, 2025, the darkest day of the year, Bonnie Hart (84) died as she lived, with her husband Bob by her side. They were married 65 years on December 17th.

Bonnie was born on November 18, 1941, a birthday she shared with her husband! She was the first-born daughter of Tom and Barbara Frampton and she took her role as big sister seriously.
