June 17, 1926 - November 18, 2009

Francis "Bud" Hyland, age 83, of Manitowish Waters, WI, died on November 18, 2009 at his home from ALS. He was born on June 17, 1926 in Milwaukee, the son of Raymond and Rose (nee Murphy) Hyland. Bud previously lived in Butler, where he owned Hyland Trucking Co. He served in the South Pacific during WWII in the US Army, raced stock cars and was an avid NASCAR fan. Bud was the District Governor of the Lions in 1990 and 1991. Bud was a member of the Manitowish Waters Lions Club, where he went on many mission trips and coordinated the Mexico Trip for District 27 C2. He was also a Wisconsin Lions Foundation Director, a Melvin Jones recipient, a Birch Sturm recipient, a Top Ten International Understanding and Cooperation Award recipient and received the Lion of the Year for Manitowish Waters, as well as the citizen of the year. Bud was also a member of the American Legion and DAV. He was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Robert, Gerald and Joseph; a sister, Ruth. Bud is survived by his beloved wife and best friend of 58 years, Shirley "Toby" Hyland; sons, Tom Hyland of Manitowish Waters, WI and Mike (Lucy) Hyland of Butler, WI; grandchildren, Carrie (Corey) Kautz, Steve (Jill) Hyland and Tony Hyland; great-granddaughter, Aubrey; brothers, George (Gwen) Hyland and Gene Hyland; sister, Ann Duffy; brother-in-law, Lawrence Nerby; sister-in-law, Joyce Hartung and many nieces, nephews and friends.
