Charlotte Evelyn Perry, of Minocqua, passed away peacefully on Sat. April 19 at the Seasons of Life Hospice House. She was 87. Charlotte was born on April 10, 1927, in Athens, WI. She spent most of her childhood summers in Merrill, WI, where she met her future husband, Phillip E. Perry. They were married in 1946 and made their home in Merrill. 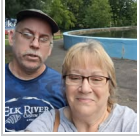
