



## Clarence Rheingans

April 26, 1923 - April 20, 2012

Clarence "Mickey" Rheingans, age 88, of Manitowish Waters, WI., passed away at Howard Young Medical Center on Friday, April 20, 2012. Mickey was born April 26, 1923 in Lindsey, WI., the son of Clem and Hattie (Bergner) Rheingans.
