Donna J. Liebenstein, age 89, of Woodruff, WI, died on Sunday, September 15, 2019 at Seasons of Life Hospice House after a long struggle with Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia and Pneumonia. Donna was born on October 16, 1929, the daughter of Alvin and Marion (nee Lindly) Jenkins. Her husband, J.O. preceded her death on June 2, 2001 at the age of 74.
