Edmund J. Coffen, age 83 of Lake Tomahawk, WI died on Wednesday November 25th at Howard Young Medical Center in Woodruff, WI. Edmund was born on September 5, 1926 in Clintonville, WI the son of Webber and Oma (nee Brewer) Coffen.

Ed is a veteran of service in WWII. There he served in the SeaBees. Ed Coffen took over a family owned general contracting company which he ran from the 1960's until turning it over to his oldest son in 1984.
