February 10, 1922 - August 29, 2011

Edward C. Garthwaite, age 89 of Lac du Flambeau, WI died on Monday, August 29th.

Edward was born on February 10, 1922 in Almond, WI the son of Lloyd and Opel (nee Irish) Garthwaite. He graduated from Oshkosh High School and Lawrence University.

Edward was a World War II veteran serving in the US Navy as Lt. Commander. Edward retired, in 1983, from Mercury Marine in Fond du Lac as Director of Human Resources.

Edward's affiliations during his lifetime were the Boy Scouts of America since age 9 and was awarded the Silver Beaver Award, was President of the Oshkosh Chamber of Commerce, Junior Chamber of Commerce member and Young Man of the Year Award in 1957 and Vice President of the Wisconsin Council of Safety from 1954 to 1955 and served two terms with the Wisconsin Advisory Council Vocational Education. He retired from Mercury Marine in 1983.

He is survived by his wife, Sharon and Children from previous marriage: Mike, John (Susan), Steve (Diane), Tom and Barbara Tyler and by 2 Granddaughters: Katie (Adam) Comens and Emily Tyler and his Sister, Kathryn.

He was preceded in death by a grandson, Andrew Tyler.
