June 28, 1923 - February 1, 2013

Evelyn M. Johnson passed away on February 1st, 2013 at the age of 89 at Howard Young Medical Center. She was born June 28, 1923 in Morris, IL. She graduated from Morris High School in 1942 and from Silver Cross Hospital in 1945 as a registered nurse. She married David A. Johnson on June 17th, 1950. He preceded her in death on November 28, 1993. In 1956, they moved from Illinois to Hazelhurst, WI. She worked 8 years at Dr. Kate's Hospital and then went to work for Dr. Henry Ashe in 1963. In 1968 Lakeland Medical Associates was developed and she continued to work there until Marshfield Clinic opened. She then worked at Marshfield Clinic until her retirement in 1996 at the age of 72. After retiring from nursing, she became a people greeter at Walmart in Minocqua and continued to work there until July 2012.

Evelyn is preceded in death by her Parents: Clarence and Mabel Olson, 3 brothers, Everett, Leroy, and Clarence Olson, and one sister, Eleanor Holloway.
