Hugh E. Rutherford Jr., 90, of Arbor Vitae passed away on June 29, 2010 at the Howard Young Medical Center in Woodruff, WI.

He was born in San Francisco, CA on July 25, 1919 to Hugh and Frances (nee Wescott) Rutherford. Hugh served his country for six years during WW II in the US-Navy on the USS Pensacola as a Chief Pharmacist Mate, all over the South Pacific. The Pensacola received 13 battle stars and Hugh served in 10 of the battles.

He was married March 24, 1945 to Mary Ann (nee Seelow) in Mill Valley, California.

He was a member of the Masonic Lodge #356 of Mill Valley, CA.

Hugh enjoyed hunting, fishing, carving birds and ducks and did beautiful lapidary work.

Hugh worked for 28 years for Prudential Insurance Co in Milwaukee. He retired to Arbor Vitae on Vandercook Lake.

He is survived by his wife of 65 years Mary Ann, daughter McLinda Ann (Gregory) Dienberg, eight grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his son Hugh Rutherford III.
