Imelda M. Duesing, age 90, of Lac du Flambeau, passed away on Monday, January 23, 2017 at Seasons of Life Hospice House in Woodruff. She was born on May 5, 1926 in Medford, the daughter of Hubert and Mary (nee Werner) Henrichs. Imelda married Melvin Duesing on September 17, 1947 in Milwaukee. They resided in Mequon until 1972.
