Janice (Jan) Lynn Boldt, 72, formerly of Sheboygan, passed away peacefully on May 6, 2023 with her brother and his wife at her side. Jan was residing at Lakeshore Assisted Living facility in Minocqua, WI, following a brief battle with lung cancer.

Jan was born to the late Henry and Myrtle (Ernst) Diener on October 10, 1950. She was raised in Sheboygan and graduated from Sheboygan North High School with the class of 1969.

On March 4, 1978, she was united in marriage to the love of her life, Lee (Weasel) Boldt at the Candlelight Wedding Chapel in Las Vegas, Nevada.
