ACKLAND - John Alden (66) of Minocqua, was called home at the Howard Young Medical Center in Woodruff, on Friday, October 8, 2021.

John was always a Wisconsin resident, and lived in the Minocqua area for many years, where he was an elder at Woodruff Baptist Church. He was well-known in the community, loved and respected by everyone who knew him.

John was born in Detroit, MI on June 26, 1955 to William and Jeanette Ackland.

He raised a family in the Green Bay area, where he worked as a machinist for Paper Converting, as well as Webex for over 12 years in Neenah, WI. He did machinist work for various other companies over the course of his working life, but his last job was as a delivery driver for Advanced Auto in Woodruff, WI.

In true Northwoods fashion, John had a great love of fishing, and was well-known in the Lac du Flambeau/Minocqua area as a fishing guide. He was also a volunteer firefighter and EMT with Minocqua Fire Department.
