Joseph "Joe" Volenec, 77, of Sayner passed away at his residence on October 11, 2017.

He was born in Cicero, IL to Joseph and Clara Volenec on February 17, 1940. Joe grew up and attended school in Cicero. After high school he attended barber college and then enlisted in the US- Navy. He served his country from 1962-68 on the USS Enterprise as a Petty Officer 3rd Class. After being honorably discharged, Joe began his career in law enforcement. He worked for the DuPage County Sheriff's Department in Wheaton, IL. He was a Homicide detective and a member of the bomb squad. He retired in 1989 and moved to Sayner, WI to enjoy hunting, fishing, dancing and karaoke. Joe loved spending time with his grandchildren in the Northwoods and was a devoted member of St. Mary's Catholic Church.
