Judith Loesch (nee Weber) of St. Germain passed away Friday, December 10, 2021, at Minocqua Health and Rehabilitation Facility following a battle with COVID. Judy was 79.

Judy was born in Milwaukee and soon thereafter the family returned to St. Germain where she grew up. Judy attended the St. Germain Grade School, known to many as the red brick schoolhouse, and graduated from Eagle River Union High School in 1960. In 1980 Judy married Alex Loesch, living in Naperville IL until they retired in 2000. Throughout her life Judy was employed as a legal secretary and office manager for various firms including Foley and Lardner Law Offices in Milwaukee, and Bell Boyd and Lloyd Law and Kathleen Zellner and Associates Law Firms in Chicago. 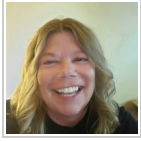
