Lisette “Zett” Fischer, 89, of Minocqua and Lac du Flambeau died on Wednesday

April 21, 2010 at Avanti Health and Rehabilitation in Minocqua. She was born May 2, 1920, in Thalheim Erzgeberge, Germany, the daughter of Richard and Helene Drechsel. In 1926, Lisette and her parents arrived in the United States from Germany and settled in Milwaukee.

Lisette belonged to the Carl Schurz Memorial Park (Mrs. Schurz was the founder of the first kindergarten in the United States). She was also a member of the Erzgeberge Youth Group, International Institute. She graduated with the first class of Rufus King High School in 1938. Following graduation, Lisette was employed by the City of Milwaukee Health Department. In 1960, Heinz and Zett purchased and managed the Holiday Inn Supper Club in Minocqua. During their 26 years of ownership, Lisette worked as the bookkeeper and hostess for the popular Northwoods supper club. She belonged to the Wisconsin Restaurant Association. She enjoyed traveling and visiting relatives in Germany. Zett especially loved spending time with Heinz tending their flower and vegetable gardens where they often shared lunches together.

Lisette married Heinz Fischer in 1941 in Milwaukee. She is survived by her husband Heinz; son Richard, Waukesha; granddaughter Cindy, Largo FL.; great granddaughter, Nicole; and a great great granddaughter, Klea. She was
