



## Lucian P. Fudacz

October 18, 1933 - December 1, 2015

Lucian P. Fudacz, age 82, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, December 1, 2015 at his home in Minocqua, Wisconsin.

Visitation is on Monday, December 7, 2015 from 9:00 – 11:00 am at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church, 5210 North Willow Road, Tripoli, WI. Mass will be at 11:00 am with a luncheon immediately following.

Lucian was born on October 18, 1933 in Swierchowa, Poland to Adolph Fudacz and Mary (Wegrzyn) Fudacz. He served in the US Army, Berlin Germany 287th Military Police Horse Platoon, the last unit in the US Army to have horses. Lucian served from March 1956 until he was Honorably Discharged in February 1958. During this time he won a Bronze Medal for Dressage (horse jumping). He also marched in many parades. On May 9, 1959, Lucian married Helene Maliszewski at Holy Innocents Catholic Church in Chicago, IL. While living in Franklin Park, IL, he and Helene raised their four children. Lucian worked at Aetna Bearing Company for 32 years as a machinist until he retired in 1995. In 1978, Lucian and Helene discovered the Northwoods and built a home on Lake Swamsauger. In 2001, Lucian and Helene retired to Minocqua. During his retirement, Lucian was a successful beekeeper and shared the honey he collected with family and friends. He was a member of the American Legion Post 89 in Minocqua and enjoyed attending their parties and steak dinners with fellow members and friends. Lucian and

Helene belong to St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church, where they were very devoted and active members. He enjoyed the outdoors, home projects, driving his pontoon boat, gardening, the science of beekeeping, but the most important thing to him was his family and enjoying spending time with them.

Lucian is survived by his wife, Helene; sons, Jeffrey and Brian (Laura); daughters, Susan (Ronald) Daye and Kristine (Pierre) Lauzon; brother, Casimir; sister-in-law, Sue Maliszewski and niece, Nancy (Chad) Correll. Lucian is further survived by his grandchildren, Matthew, Maggie, Lucas, Lexie and Jessica. He is preceded in death by his parents.
