Margaret J. Gaulke, 82, of Lac du Flambeau passed away at Avanti Health and Rehabilitation Center in Minocqua on April 15, 2010. She was born in Eagle River, WI to Dr. Alfred Guth DDS and Naomi (nee Mertz) Guth on June 23, 1927.

She attended and graduated from Central States Teacher College (now UW-Stevens Point).

She married Ellsworth Gaulke in 1953 and he preceded her in death in 1993. She taught at the Lac du Flambeau Grade School until 1959. She and her husband owned and operated the Tower from 1959-1972. After selling the business, she returned to teaching until 1988.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, a son Kurt and two brothers, Dick and Lawrence.
