Marvin L. Neff, 85, of St. Germain passed away at his home on Friday May 21, 2010.

He was born in Black Creek, WI to Ralph and Elsie Neff on August 22, 1924. He served in the Asiatic Pacific Theatre for three and half years during WW II in the US Army.

Marvin worked for Trapp Brothers for many years, owned the Northern Motel for five years and owned and operated Neff Shoe Repair in Wakefield, MI and St. Germain, WI for over 20 years.

He was the originator and premier president of the Cross Country Cruisers. He spent much time with the DNR establishing snowmobile trails in the area. He was also one of the original volunteer firemen for the Arbor Vitae Fire Dept under Bill Egtvedt.

He was preceded in death by his first wife of 25 years, Vera; brothers Orville (former Minocqua Police Chief) and Donald Neff and sisters Mildred Phipps and Dorothy Bernhardt.

Marvin is survived by his wife of 22 years Nancy, daughter Marlene of Camarillo, CA; sons, Paul (Melanie) Kairis, Phil (Michelle) Kairis and Perry (Nancy) Kairis; five grandchildren, Susan, Amanda, Ashley, Drew and Cody. He is further survived by many loving nieces and nephews.
