



Nancy A. Pfennig

September 8, 1944 - January 10, 2019

Nancy Anne (Jungers) Pfennig age 74 of Boulder Junction WI died January 10, 2019 surrounded by loved ones after an almost three-year battle with cancer.

Nancy was born on September 8, 1944 to Hugo and Marie Jungers in Sheboygan, WI. Her youth was spent in Dacada, WI. Nancy attended Random Lake High School and went on to attend the University of Wisconsin - La Crosse. There she met Roger Pfennig.
