November 1, 1933 - February 24, 2010

Norbert Joseph Bartnicki, age 76, died on Wednesday, February 24, 2010 at his residence in Minocqua. Norb was born on November 1, 1933 in Chicago Illinois. He graduated from the University of Illinois College of Pharmacy in 1955. Norb married Peg on June 25, 1955. He served in the Military from 1957 – 1959 as the pharmacist in charge of the 10th Field Hospital in Wurtzburg, Germany.
