The “King of Sayner”, Orin W. Sayner, 97, passed away at his home on Friday September 16, 2022.

He was born in Sayner to George and Mary (nee Ernst) Sayner on September 7, 1925. He served in the US-Navy, being honorably discharged in 1946.
