August 2, 1942 - September 26, 2014

Thomas F. Hoban, 72, went to the Lord on Friday, September 26, 2014 surrounded by his family at his home, after a courageous battle with a rare disease, amyloidosis. He was born on August 2, 1942 to John and Pat Hoban in Minneapolis., MN. In 1959, his family moved to Wisconsin on Lake Tippecanoe. He graduated from Lakeland Union High School in 1960 and worked for Emmerich Electric under the direction of John Nolan. In 1961, he enlisted in the Navy. He attended Great Lakes Naval Center. Tom was stationed on the USS IWO Jima (LPH-2) in the Pacific Ocean. While in the Navy he saw Hawaii, the Philippines, Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Japan. After the Navy, he met Mary A. Draeger. They were married in 1966 at Our Lady Queen of the Universe Church in Woodruff, WI. They moved to Wausau where Tom attended North Central Technical Institute. He graduated at the top of his class with a degree in electronics and was hired by IBM following his graduation. He worked in Stevens Point, WI at IBM for 17 years and then transferred to Boulder, CO in 1980. He worked for IBM for 35 years. During his time as a Senior Program Specialist, with IBM, he traveled to Denmark and Europe. He received many Outstanding Achievement Awards and 3 Mears Service Awards for IBM. After retiring in 2000 from IBM, he moved with his wife Mary to Lake Tippecanoe and built their retirement home. Tom was a Jack of all trades. He could bake a pie as well as build a house. He always had a beautiful yard and garden. Tom is survived by his wife, Mary of 48 years; One son, Bryan (Jodi) Hoban of Irma, WI; Three Daughters, Kelly (Joe)
