Vera Mae Perry, age 66, a long time resident of Lac du Flambeau, passed away suddenly at her home on the afternoon of April 14th, 2015.

Born in Hayward, WI on October 18th 1949, Vera married Lyman Perry on May 25th 1966 and traveled the world with Lyman and his U.S. Air Force career of 20 years. She raised her two children, Dale and Brenda in places such as Japan, Alaska, Washington, Utah, Michigan, Mississippi, and Maine before settling down in Wisconsin near family.

Vera enjoyed opening her home to foster children and was a foster parent for 38 different children throughout her lifetime. She enjoyed bingo, traveling, and “people watching” at different events. She retired recently from the Lake of Torches Casino where she worked as a representative of the Players Club.

Vera is survived by her son, Dale (Staci) Perry of Green Bay, WI and her daughter, Brenda Perry of Lac du Flambeau as well as her four grandchildren, Brittany Perry (Milwaukee), Kelsey Perry (La Crosse), Vanessa Peterson (Lac du Flambeau) and Riley Perry (Green Bay) as well as many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Vera was preceded in death by her parents, William and Margaret Korne and all of her eight siblings.
