Victoria M. Emetti, 82 yrs. old died on Jan. 15, 2019 after a long but courageous battle with

She started every day with a cup of coffee in hand, followed by taking pleasure in gardening, shopping, knitting, interior design, and spending time with her small dogs. I believe her greatest treasure was spending time with her wonderful family and friends. She was so blessed to have relationships with her children, grand-children, and great grand-children. Near or far she tried to maintain some contact despite her failing health. She rarely missed a morning "hello" with her dear friend's at local coffee spots around town. She found great pleasure on her Sunday drives to Mercer, Wisconsin, where she spent afternoons with her loving daughter, son, and son-in-law. They all shared many fun filled times together. She looked forward to her Milwaukee trips to share time with her other daughter, and her four kind-hearted and adventuresome grandsons. Whom she moved in with last year and lived with until she passed on to Heaven's Gates. They made her laugh and she made them laugh as well. She was blessed to have her beloved son and his helpful and compassionate family living in the area as well. She enjoyed attending family parties, religious ceremonies, and as of late, regular morning coffee runs to her favorite Panera Restaurant with him and family members. She so cherished time spent with her beloved brother, sister-in-law, sister, and many family members in the Chicagoland area as well. She expressed great appreciation time and again for the special occasions spent with family. Even while her health had been failing her she was determined to attend parties and picnics given by such devoted individuals.
